

The following pages will provide a close 'look back' at what the Bible reveals regarding *The Two Adams* of our spiritual history as believers in the Lord Jesus Christ. Every person who has not yet placed their faith in Jesus – is right now – whether they understand this or not ... they are "in Adam." They are totally impacted right now by all of the seven tragic consequences that came out of Adam's initial rebellion against God in Genesis 3:6. What these seven tragic consequences are will be unfolded below.

What we are about to discover is that when Jesus as "the Second Adam – the Last Adam" came into the world in His incarnation as the Son of God into flesh – He actually set about to "walk the same path" of events that the First Adam had walked – but this time Jesus as the Second Adam would do it with perfect obedience to God the Father!

The First Adam:



Birthed by the Spirit → Tempted → Separated from God → Death



The Second Adam:



Birthed by the Spirit → Tempted → Separated from God → Death



Those who are given to the Son by the Father are saved and transformed by faith in that very Son of God whose life-work defeated death in *a step-by-step march* that *began when He was birthed* by God's creative work of *the Spirit* in a virgin – just as Adam was uniquely brought to life by the creative working of *the Spirit* in bringing humanity into existence from the dust of the ground.

It is a profound revelation that we are given when the Bible presents this amazing connection of the working of the Spirit *first* in <u>the creation account</u> of Adam in **Genesis chapter 2** – and then **second** in the announcement of <u>the coming birth</u> of Jesus – the **Second Person** of the Trinity – by the angel to Mary in **Luke chapter 1**.

Then the Son of God began to fulfill "all righteousness" until He completed His faithful work by dying as a curse before the Holy God in the place of His sheep on the Cross --- even though in His own life He had been completely sinless.

THE FIRST ADAM



Separation is immediate:

- between Adam and Eve

Genesis 3:7

⁷ Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked. And *they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loincloths*.

- between Adam/Eve and God

Genesis 3:8

⁸ And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and *the man* and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

Separation also soon occurred between *Adam and Eve's* first two sons as *Cain* actually killed his brother *Abel* (Genesis 4:8)!

THE "SECOND ADAM"



Separation had to be experienced therefore also by the Second Adam Jesus:

Matthew 27:46

⁴⁶ "My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me?"

We now – because of the separation on the Cross that the Second Adam was willing to experience on behalf of His people, His Bride, now we forevermore have free access to God the Father!

Matthew 27:51

⁵¹ And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.

Hebrews 10:19-22

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by the new and living way that He opened for us through the curtain, that is, through His flesh, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

When Adam sinned, the dominion of the earth transferred from Adam to Satan. Satan leads a vast, organized, powerful force of demons opposed to God and committed to destroying God's people. He accuses and tempts humans (see Job 1; 1 Chronicles 21:1; Zechariah 3). The title Satan means "adversary." He is also called the Devil (which means "slanderer"), the Evil One, the accuser, the tempter, Belial (which means "worthlessness"), Beelzebub (a name given to the fly-god in Ekron), the prince of the devils, the prince of the power of the air, the prince of this world, the god of this age, the great dragon, and that old Serpent. He is the god of this world, blinding the minds of unbelievers until God shines the liberating light of Christ into their hearts (2 Corinthians 4:1-6). "The whole world lies in the power of the evil one" (1 John 5:19).

All of this unfolded in the Fall.

But – even in this setting the Gospel begins to come to light – one step at a time.

The "Second Adam" is subtly introduced: Genesis 3:15 – 1 Peter 1:18-20

¹⁵ "I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and *her Offspring; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."*

¹⁸ knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, ¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of *a Lamb without blemish or spot*. ²⁰ *He was foreknown before the foundation of the world* but was made manifest in the last times for the sake of you



In His **RESURRECTION** this "**Second Adam**" triumphed victoriously over death with life.

THE RESULT

With this profound teaching as our backdrop, let's allow the Bible itself to clarify and define our understanding of sin – and therefore of **the pervasiveness of our need** – and then our **awareness of** and our **embracing of the complete solution** that has been provided to us by God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit.

Why is this so important? It is vital for our lives because a deficient understanding of the implications of sin will always result (usually without us even being aware of it) in devaluing *the glory* of God in our mind and heart.

In other words, this is a very serious issue.

The principle that we must always keep in mind is:

In both physical and spiritual realities (and especially in the issues of sin and salvation) diagnosing the disease accurately is <u>the most important</u> <u>step</u> toward obtaining its proper cure.

After the initial Fall of Adam and Eve into sin – all humans (because they are born "in Adam") will always continue to resist God – which is exactly what they want to do – **until** God changes their mind and heart – and sets their will free – so that they actually ... for the first time ... actually want to submit to God.

(1) The unregenerate person's **NATURE** is under God's wrath

Ephesians 2:3

³ among whom **we all** once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and **were by nature children of wrath**, **like the rest of mankind**.

(2) The unregenerate person's **SPIRIT** is dead to God

Ephesians 2:1-2

¹ And you were *dead in the trespasses and sins* ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—

(3) The unregenerate person's <u>HEART</u> is evil in all its ways

Genesis 6:5

⁵ The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that **every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually**.

Genesis 8:21

²¹ And when the LORD smelled the pleasing aroma, the LORD said in His heart, "I will never again curse the ground because of man, for *the intention of man's heart is evil from his youth*. Neither will I ever again strike down every living creature as I have done."

(4) The unregenerate person's MIND is darkened to God's truth

Romans 1:18, 21-23

¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness *suppress the truth*.

²¹ For although they knew God, *they did not honor Him as God* or *give thanks to Him*, but they *became futile in their thinking*, and *their foolish hearts were darkened*.

²² Claiming to be wise, *they became fools*, ²³ and exchanged *the glory* of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.

2 Corinthians 4:4a

⁴ In their case the god of this world has *blinded the minds of the unbelievers*

¹⁴ The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for *they are folly to him*, and *he is not able to understand them* because they are spiritually discerned.

(5) The unregenerate person's **WILL** is a slave to sin and unable to obey

Romans 3:9-12

⁹ What then? Are we Jews any better off? No, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both Jews and Greeks, are *under sin*, ¹⁰ as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; ¹¹ *no one understands; no one seeks for God*. ¹² All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; *no one does good, not even one.*"

2 Timothy 2:24-26

²⁴ And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, ²⁵ correcting his opponents with gentleness. *God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth*, ²⁶ and they may come to their senses and *escape from the snare of the devil, after being captured by him to do his will*.

³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is **a** slave to sin."

He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies."

⁵ Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, *unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God*. ⁶ That which is *born of the flesh is flesh*, and that which is *born of the Spirit is spirit*. ⁷ Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' ⁸ The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is *born of the Spirit*." [See <u>Ezekiel 36:22, 25-27 above on page 78</u> for the prediction of this being "born again of water and the Spirit"]

- ⁴ In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, **to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ**, who is the image of God.
 - (7) The unregenerate person's <u>BODY</u> is destined to die just as their spirit has already suffered death

Romans 6:23

²³ For *the wages of sin is death*, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:19-23

¹⁹ For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. ²⁰ For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope ²¹ that *the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God*. ²² For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. ²³ And not only the creation, but *we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit*, groan inwardly *as we wait eagerly for* adoption as sons, *the redemption of our bodies*.

On the fact that all of Christ's redeemed Bride will at His Second Coming be given a new spiritual body – a redeemed body – turn now to 1 Corinthians 15 and read verses 44-47, and 49. Also turn to Luke 16:19-23 and note that in this parable of Jesus Lazarus and Abraham in heaven have bodies that can be seen!

With this sober understanding of the implications of sin we can now better grasp the importance of the following two texts:

1 Corinthians 10:31

³¹ So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

Hebrews 11:6

⁶ And *without faith* it is <u>impossible</u> to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him.

In review, the condition of unbelieving and unregenerate people --- is that:




- (1) their **NATURE** is under God's wrath
- (2) their SPIRIT is dead to God
- (3) their **HEART** is evil in all its ways
- (4) their MIND is darkened to God's truth
- (5) their <u>WILL</u> is a slave to sin and unable to obey
- (6) their <u>SPIRITUAL EYES</u> are blinded to the glory of God's beauty
- (7) and their <u>BODY</u> is destined to die just as their spirit has already suffered death.

Because of all of these implications of sin upon humanity the following chart describes the plight of humanity:

The Difference Between Adam in Genesis 2 and The Regenerated Believer with Christ's Righteousness

2 Cor. 5:17, 21b – Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.
